

2023 Jews Harp Poll Dorset Sale Report

Sale report from the Jews Harp Poll Dorset, Baynton Border Leicester and Mission White Suffolk Ram Sale

Jews Harp Poll Dorset Stud (Michael O’Sullivan)

Total clearance of 120 rams, top \$2300, average \$1640

Baynton Border Leicester Stud (Martin O’Sullivan)

Clearance of 48 from 60 rams, top \$2000, average \$1042

Mission White Suffolk Stud (Anthony O’Sullivan)

Total clearance of 20 rams, top \$1700, average \$1100

188 rams sold from across the three studs going to 38 buyers.

Jews Harp Poll Dorset stud achieved a total clearance of rams, at their ninth on property sale.

Lot 4 of the Poll Dorset selection reached the top price of \$2300, it was purchased by Anthony Barri, AP and KA Barri, Heathcote. This ram carried a Terminal Carcass production index (TCP) of 159.0, Post Weaning Weight (PWWT) 16.4 and Post Eye Muscle Depth (PEMD) of 3.5.

Bungeeltap Glenhope, Glenardagh East Sidonia, and Bonoon Mildura, were volume buyers of the Poll Dorset rams.

Lot 142 purchased by JH Hay and Son and Lot 145 purchased by Bungeeltap were the top price Border Leicester rams sold for \$2000. Lot 142 carried a Maternal Weaning Weight (MWWT) of 1.36 and a Post Eye Muscle Depth (PEMD) of 1.43. Lot 145 carried a Maternal Weaning Weight (MWWT) of 1.25 and a Post Eye Muscle Depth (PEMD) of 2.38.

The volume buyer of the Border Leicester rams was Stock Range Glenhope.

Lots 125 and 126 were the top price Mission White Suffolk rams, purchased by Andy and Carmel Hay, Kamarooka. Lot 125 carried a PWWT of 16.7 and TCP of 144.7 and Lot 126 carried a PWWT of 16.3 and TCP of 147.4.

The volume buyer of the Mission White Suffolks was Carnebrae Pastoral, Tocumwal.
